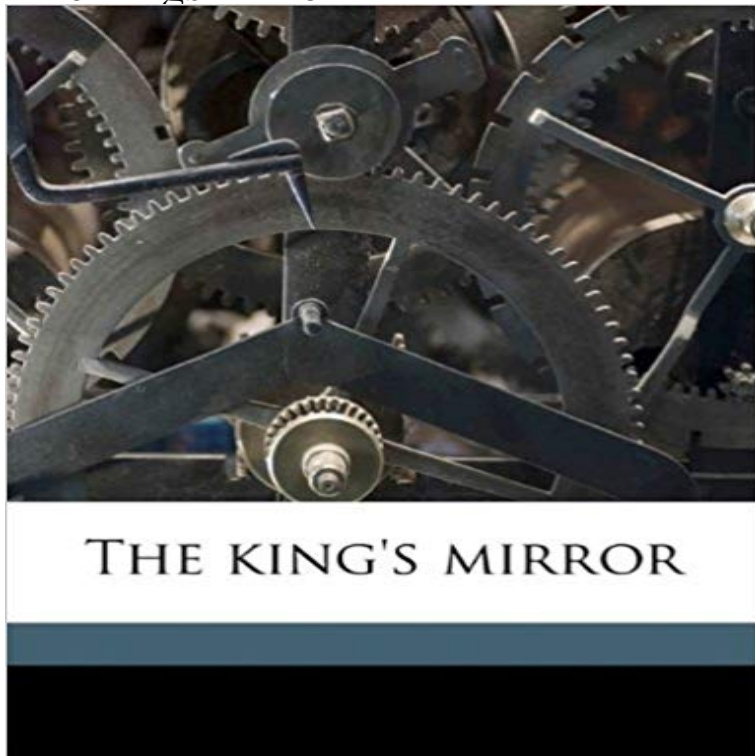


## The kings mirror
