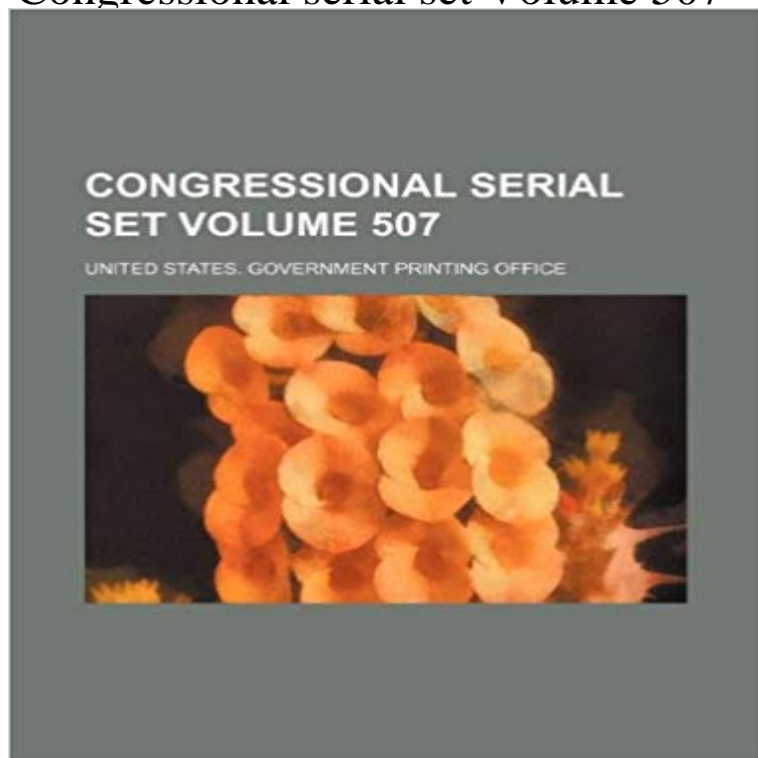

He replied to me that he had full and plenary instructions carried out by him sealed, not to be opened until he reached a given point; but he would not exhibit them like slaves did their papers; that he had no fear of his power being impaired by the instructions of General Kearny; and, from his-confident manner, I felt fully assured that he had counterpart, or paramount instructions to those of General Kearny,

and continued in that opinion up to my arrival in Washington city, in July, or August of the present year...
